Established in 1922, El Charro Café of Tucson is the Nation's Oldest Mexican Restaurant in continuous operation by the same family, featuring traditional Sonoran-styled cuisine. After lunch, we embark on our guided Tucson Tour, where we will see all this historic Pueblo has to offer! Sites will include various Barrios, historic downtown, the University of Arizona area, San Xavier Mission & more! We will head back to our hotel after the tour in the early evening, with plenty of time to relax by the pool and enjoy the complimentary evening reception.

Time to hit the caves! We drive south of Tucson today for an interesting cave adventure, touring both Kartchner Caverns State Park & Colossal Cave Mountain Park. Here, we will uncover the role that water plays in creating the caves, walk the original trails & see several column formations that are up to 45,000 years old! On our way to Colossal Cave Mountain Park, a delicious BBQ lunch is planned, complete with mountain views at Del Lago Golf Club. We take the Classic Cave Tour at Colossal Mountain! While on this tour, you will learn of the cave's history, legends & geological structures. You will have free time afterwards to enjoy other park activities - Feel free to relax in the picnic area, enjoy a stroll through the butterfly garden, visit the tortoise desert habitat exhibit, the petting zoo or grab a snack at the café. <p><b>SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2020</b></p>	<p>Today we head south! We will meet again with our step-on guide for a tour of both Tombstone and Bisbee, Arizona. While in Tombstone, we’ll walk in the footsteps of some of the legends of the Old West, experiencing the town that was too tough to die. Bisbee, Arizona was once the richest city between St. Louis &amp; San Francisco! It is now a thriving community of artists with tons of rich history. Lunch will be included at Big Nose Kate’s Saloon in Tombstone, which was once the Grand Hotel, one of the first hotels in the state of AZ. This will be a fantastic guided tour as we learn about two southern Arizona towns with so much history! **IMPORTANT CAVE TOUR INFORMATION:**

**Kartchner Cave Tour:** Because this is a “live” cave, formed primarily from the flow of water, please expect humidity & a retained temperature of 70°F. This tour may involve more turns, some narrow passageways & dim lighting. Close-Toed, comfortable shoes are required. Shoes that have been worn within any other cave are not permitted to be worn on this tour due to transmitting unknown cavern soils & minerals from cave to cave. Walking Distance: ½ Mile

**Colossal Cave Tour:** This cave tour is accessible, with wider & more brightly lit paths. Please note that there are steps with handrails while on this tour, with plenty of opportunity to stop along the way. This cavern also maintains a comfortable 70°F. Close-Toed, comfortable shoes are required. Shoes worn on this tour are okay to have been in other caverns. Walking Distance: ½ Mile

**Both Cave Tours:** Cave tours are both entirely walkable, you will **not** have to squat, crawl or climb during either visit. If you use a walker or cane, please be sure the bottom has a rubber end to protect cavern floors. Tours are conducted by Arizona State Park Experts who will guide you safely & knowledgeably throughout the caverns. Please contact us if you have any questions or if you are a traveler with mobility restrictions. Thank you!
