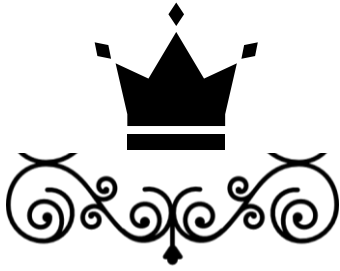
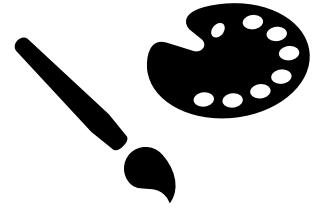

<p>MONDAY, APRIL 20, 2020</p>	<p>This morning we will depart at 6:30 AM from Evergreen Commons, Auxiliary Parking Lot on 20th St, Holland, Michigan. Second pick up is in Grand Rapids at 7:15 AM at the AMC 3000 Alpine Ave NW, Walker, 49544, lower level of the parking lot. Final pick-up location at 8:00 AM from Gaines Township Meijer, 1801 Marketplac Dr. SE, Caledonia, MI 49316, the Garden parking lot nearest Panera. Experience one of the most riveting Bible stories of the Old Testament as it comes to life with magnificent sets, special effects and live animals in this brand-new, original stage production! Enjoy a traditional, family-styled, Amish dinner tonight as a group before we head back to our hotel. (B & D)</p>
<p>WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22, 2020</p>	<p>Breakfast is included once again before we continue our journey! We will arrive at The Brandywine River Museum, which showcases the art of Andrew Wyeth, a major American realist painter, his father, N.C. Wyeth, illustrator of several children’s classics, and more Wyeth family artists. Along with admission to the museum, we will enjoy a curated tour of the Wyeth Home and Artist Studio. An included lunch will be enjoyed here as well. Next, we visit Winterthur Garden & Library, an American estate and museum in Winterthur, Delaware. As of 2011, it houses one of the most important collections of Americana in the U.S. and was the former home of Henry Francis du Pont. He was a renowned antiques collector and horticulturist, encouraging guests from all over to view his collections at the estate. Enjoy dinner on your own in town as we head back to Lancaster tonight. 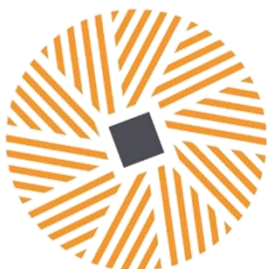
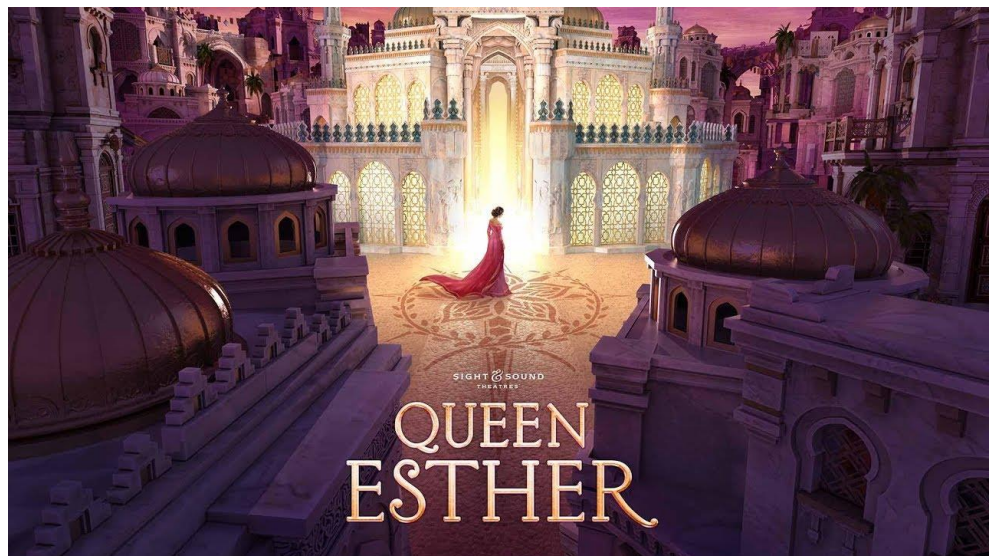
