JUNE 15,
2020**

This morning we will depart from the lower level of the **AMC Movie Theatre at 6:30 AM**, 3000 Alpine Ave, NW, Walker, MI 49544. Our second pick-up location is at **Evergreen Commons in the Auxiliary Parking lot** (the corner of 20th & Central Ave) at **7:30 AM**. As we begin our tour to Louisville, Kentucky, there's a planned stop for some coffee & donuts as well as lunch along the way. Once arriving to Louisville and checking into our hotel, we board the Belle of Louisville for a relaxing and delicious dinner cruise down the Ohio River, which has always sustained the city of Louisville! After the river cruise, it's time to head back to the hotel for a restful night - We have a full schedule for the next day as we head to Nashville, Tennessee! **(D) (CR)**

This morning we head out for an adventurous breakfast hosted by the Kentucky Derby Museum. Dedicated to preserving the history of the Kentucky Derby, it first opened its doors to the public in the spring of 1985 and has been welcoming groups to learn and experience famous race ever since. You will enjoy a full breakfast on the sidelines as we watch the horses train and complete their morning workouts! After breakfast, we take a guided tour of the track and surrounding area of the park.

Afterwards, spend time in downtown Louisville's Fourth Street Live! This district is home to tons shopping and places you can grab some lunch. Maybe try the infamous Food Network's Guy Fieri's Smokehouse? In 2012, his restaurant was inducted into the American Royal BBQ Hall of Fame – Yum! Batter up! Our next tour is the Louisville Slugger Factory & Museum!

From here, we make our way to downtown Nashville! For the remainder of the week, the group will stay at the newly constructed Drury Plaza Hotel Nashville in the heart of the city. Each night at Drury Hotels, a complimentary Kickback Meal is held for guests. Enjoy dinner at the hotel, or feel free to venture into downtown Nashville! **(B) (CR)**



**WEDNESDAY,
JUNE 17,
2020**

All aboard the trolley! The Nashville highlights trolley tour begins after breakfast. You will have the opportunity to see the city up-close and stop by some of Nashville's biggest attractions during this guided tour. We end the trolley ride at Peg Leg Porker BBQ. After opening in 2013, Peg Leg Porker BBQ is known for its southern hospitality and has won numerous awards for their famous Tennessee BBQ, which is smoked fresh daily with classic sides made from scratch using local ingredients.

The historic Ryman Auditorium is our next visit. This is where bluegrass was born, where some of the biggest country music stars have performed, where well-known duos met and where careers and record deals were made. The Grand Ole Opry is another historic Nashville auditorium. We will take guided tour of venue and learn about this American country music stage's history since opening in 1925. Dinner is available tonight as the Kickback meal at our hotel or on your own at a Nashville restaurant! **(B) (L) (CR)**

**THURSDAY,
JUNE 18,
2020**

After breakfast at our hotel, it's a quick ride over to the Johnny Cash Museum! The museum holds the world's largest and most comprehensive collection of Johnny Cash memorabilia. The Country Music Hall of Fame is keeping history alive with its extensive, permanent objects collection and honors the music of classic and current artists, showcasing one-of-a-kind artifacts. Experience the music of outlaws like Willie Nelson and Waylon Jennings, alongside the timeless King, and celebrated contemporary storytellers. There will be plenty of time to enjoy the CMHOF at your own pace as well as enjoying lunch on your own at the museum or at one of the many surrounding area restaurants.

Afterwards, we head over to the RCA Studio B for a tour! It first became known as one of the cradles of the "Nashville Sound" in the 1960s, where artists like Elvis, Dolly Parton, Jim Reeves, Dottie West, Bobby Bare, Chet Atkins and many more, recorded some of their most popular songs.

Since this is our last evening in the music city, a group dinner will be included in downtown Nashville! **(B) (D) (CR)**

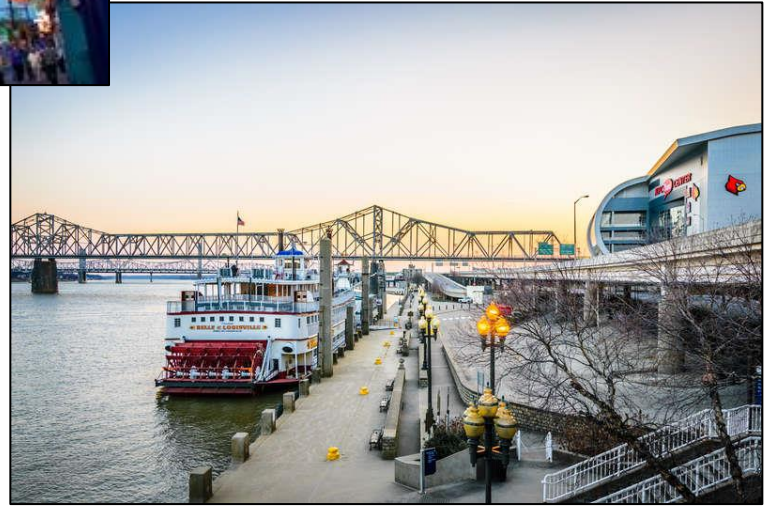
